



Covid19 – Rules for entry


Status: 15 December 2020 – 16:00 hrs


Entry to Austria

✓ The form *Quarantäneverpflichtung* (obligatory quarantine) must be filled out upon entering.

! You have to be in quarantine for 10 days. The quarantine must be spent at home. 

✓ After the fifth day of quarantine you can take a test (PCR test or anti-gene test).


If this test is negative, quarantine is over. 

✓ Covid19 PCR tests or Covid19 anti-gene tests are valid. 

! Exception – Entry with negative Covid19- test only is possible for:


- ✓ Persons who have to enter Austria for professional reasons (e.g. work in care sector)
- ✓ Persons who need to go to court or to an authority
- ✓ Persons who accompany someone during a medical treatment

! The Covid19-test must have been taken within the previous 72 hours.

! You need to pay for the test yourself. 

Entry – no test and no quarantine required for:

- Persons who regularly work in Austria; except when working in care (commuters).
- Persons who regularly visit their family (commuters)
- Persons entering due to unforeseeable family situations (e.g. death)
- Persons entering from the following countries:
 - Australia
 - Finland
 - Ireland
 - Iceland
 - Japan
 - Norway
 - South Korea
 - Uruguay
 - Vatican
